## EXTRA INFORMATION

### AFTER APPLICATION CARE

- ▶ To remove any stains use a sponge to clean it, soap solution can be used for better results. Make sure you can let the surface dry for 2 weeks before you started cleaning.

### TECHNICAL DETAILS

- A. Drying time:** Surface dry time 2-4 Hours
- B. Flash point IS101/1987 Part 1, Sec 6:** Non-Flamable
- C. Stability of thinned paint:** To be used within 4 hours

### CAUTION TO TAKE

- ▶ It can catch fire
- ▶ Should not be swallowed. If you've eaten something, get help right away.
- ▶ Before applying, protect your eyes. In the event of contact with the eyes, flush with water right away and seek simple assistance.
- ▶ Thoroughly wash the skin with soap and water if in contact with product. If irritation occurs or continues, seek medical assistance.
- ▶ Do not inhale spray or vapour. To prevent dust inhalation while sanding and surface preparation, it is advised to wear a suitable nose pad.
- ▶ Never spill leftover paint into waterways or drains. In the event of spills, contain spillage using sand or soil.
- ▶ No additional Lead, Mercury, or Chromium compounds.

### PREVENTIVE MEASURES

- ▶ If the temperature is expected to fall within four hours of application or if the ambient temperature is less than 10°C, avoid applying.
- ▶ Avoid overstretching or over thinning the brush,
- ▶ Use only Classics Paints colourants while tinting,
- ▶ Strain the mixture before using & whisk it well.
- ▶ Before usage and right away after tinter addition, tinted paints require thorough shaking.
